


# CONTEM




























### OUR LEGACY

## AGENDA: ADDRESSING MEMBER STATE ACCOUNTABILITY FOR GENOCIDE AND ETHNIC CLEANSING UNDER INTERNATIONAL LAW

Genocide and ethnic cleansing, among the gravest violations of human dignity, persist amid political inertia, weak enforcement, and selective outrage. This committee seeks to move beyond symbolic condemnation by advancing actionable frameworks for accountability, prevention, and redress, challenging delegates to balance state sovereignty with urgent humanitarian responsibility.

In light of the alarming rise in hostage-taking and the unlawful detention of combatants by both state and non-state actors, the United Nations Security Council convenes to confront one of the most pressing challenges in modern conflict. These practices, increasingly used as instruments of war and suppression, undermine international humanitarian law and threaten global stability. This session calls upon member states to scrutinize the role of all actors in perpetuating these violations, to strengthen accountability mechanisms and resolve this issue once and for all.
